Key Regulatory & Industry Requirements

Area	Purpose
FCC (USA)	Controls RF emissions and interference for wireless devices
ISED (Canada)	Canadian equivalent of FCC authorization
CE / RED (EU)	EU Conformity for safety, EMC, and radio performance
PTCRB	Cellular device certification for North American carrier readiness
GCF	Global cellular certification to support international market access
Wi-Fi / Bluetooth	Interoperability and branding certifications

Typical Compliance Flow

Planning → Documentation → Pre-Compliance Testing → Certification Testing → Filing & Labeling

- Start compliance strategy early in product design
- Use pre-certified modules where possible
- Align regulatory and carrier requirements upfront
- Plan for testing risks and schedule buffers
